TYPE THREE - THE ACHIEVER

The story of you only makes sense within the big story **OF GOD**.

1. Achievers are constantly thinking about the **FUTURE**.

Mark 10:17 As Jesus started on his way, a man ran up to him and fell on his knees before him. "Good teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

2. Achievers want to make a DIFFERENCE.

Mark 10:20-22 "Teacher," he declared, "all these I have kept since I was a boy." 21 Jesus looked at him and loved him. "One thing you lack," he said. "Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." 22 At this the man's face fell. He went away sad, because he had great wealth.

3. It's hard for an Achiever to BE REAL.

Mark 10:23, 26-27 Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God!" 26 The disciples were even more amazed, and said to each other, "Who then can be saved?" 27 Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God."

- 4. The Achiever reflects God's HOPE.
- 5. The beauty of the Achiever: They're not limited to what we see in the world. They see things that AREN'T.

- 6. The motivation of Achievers: To be **SUCCESSFUL**.
- 7. The Achiever's inner need to ACHIEVE.
- 8. The Achiever's core sin: LYING.
- 9. The underlying emotion of the Achiever is **SHAME**.

How do I love an Achiever?

- 1. Encourage them to celebrate success.
- 2. Be real with them.
- 3. Encourage them to connect with how they're feeling.

Praise God for Threes because: There's no compelling vision without you. There's bigger Kingdom impact with you. You see how ministry can be done. You have big faith. You're ambitious for people seeing hope in Jesus. You sacrifice greatly. Thank God for you!
