BACK FROM THE DEAD

(Ephesians 2:1-22)

Ephesians 2:1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins,

Two wrong assumptions:

1. "I don't need to be saved...and if I do, I can save MYSELF."

Three ways we try to save ourselves:

- 1. Good WORKS.
- 2. Religious RITUAL.
- 3. **COMPARISON**...other people are worse.
- 2. "I've been a Christian MY WHOLE LIFE."

Let's understand what salvation is:

- 1. Salvation is by God's **GRACE**...a gift!
- 2. Salvation is received by **FAITH**.

Acts 16:30-31 He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" 31 They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved--you and your household."

Three parts to saving faith:

- 1. I must **HEAR** it.
- 2. I must ACCEPT it.
- 3. I must **COMMIT** to it.
- 3. Salvation is not earned by **WORKS**.
- 4. Salvation is demonstrated by **GODLINESS**.

God's Big Plan:

To bring those who are spiritually **DEAD** and make them **ALIVE** in Christ Jesus.
