## SPIRITUAL WARFARE

## **HEADQUARTERS**

(Ephesians 5:21 - 6:9)

Three areas of your life which make up your headquarters:

- 1. **MARRIAGE** or leading in your **DATING** relationship.
- 2. **PARENTING** or obedience to your **PARENTS**.
- 3. **WORKPLACE** as an employee or in your leadership of employees.

Submission is the **<u>TWO-WAY</u>** sacrificial path of <u>**LOVE**</u>.

- 4. A man's greatest need: **RESPECT**.
- 5. A woman's greatest need: LOVE.
  - Positional Leadership: Husband <u>LEADS</u> his wife. (Jesus is the head of the church) The church allows Jesus to take responsibility for it, so wives allow their husbands to take responsibility for them.
  - Functional Leadership: Husband <u>SACRIFICES</u> for his wife for her well-being. (Jesus laid down his life for the church out of love). Husbands you lay down your selfishness and lay down your life and take responsibility for your wife's well-being.

• Identity Leadership: The two are **ONE** flesh. Problems occur when the husband demands respect without love. Or the wife demands love without giving respect. That puts you on the crazy cycle!

John Maxwell: The 360° Leader.

Myth #1: The Position Myth: "I can't lead if I'm not AT THE TOP."

Myth #5: The Freedom Myth: "When I get to the top, I'll no longer **BE LIMITED**."

Myth #6: The Potential Myth: "I can't reach my potential if I'm not a **TOP LEADER**." God will utilize your full potential regardless of position.

Myth #7: The All-or-Nothing Myth: "If I can't get to the top, then I won't **TRY TO LEAD**."

You cannot be a great **LEADER**, unless you first become a great **FOLLOWER**.
