(Luke 12:13-21)

- 1. What is an inheritance, but the surplus **LEFT-OVER** by another life?
- 2. Jesus is all about justice, but He is much more interested in **THE MOTIVES** for which you fight for justice.
- Our problem, in light of the Gospel, is that each of us
 OVERESTIMATES what is due him/her in comparison of what is due to your NEIGHBOR.
- 4. You come into a surplus and you begin to think, "What should I do with my **EXTRA**?"
- "He did not realize that the bellies of the poor were much safer storerooms than his barns." - Augustine

5. The **FOOL-PROOF** plan: "To live with ease, eat, drink and rejoice" is, in fact, the plan of the **FOOL**.

6. A soul created in "Imago-Dei," the Image of God, will never be satisfied with **SELF-INDULGENCE.**

7. **YOUR LIFE** is on loan from God, just like **YOUR STUFF**.

Luke 12:21 "This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

8. If you only **WORK** for self, you will fail to **ACQUIRE** wealth for God.
