Faithful Instructions

This is God's Will for You in Christ Jesus

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

God wants his people to be **SEEKERS**.

- 1. Seekers get WISE counsel. (Proverbs 24:6)
 - Get as MUCH counsel as possible.
 - Get as MATURE counsel as possible:

 $Spiritual\ maturity,\ Emotional\ maturity,\ Experiential\ maturity.$

- 2. Seekers **THINK** wisely.
 - Consider the options: Positives & negatives of each.
 - Circumstances are only indicators; they don't dictate a decision.
- 3. Seekers **LISTEN** wisely.

Listen often. Once is not enough.

THREE TESTS OF LISTENING:

- The test of **TIME**.
- The test of **SCRIPTURE**.
- The test of INTERNAL PEACE.

God doesn't give us the "destination." He wants to be our daily guide. Therefore, God's guidance is revealed in small increments on a daily basis.

Listen and respond when God CLOSES or OPENS doors.

- 4. Seekers **ACT** wisely.
 - Don't passively expect God to do everything for you.
 - Seek employment, send resumes, send applications, visit campuses, take tests, make the proper contacts.
- 5. Seekers **REFLECT** to know themselves well.
 - What is my personality type? What is my spiritual gift?
 - What sin am I prone to? Would this option negatively affect my weakness?
 - What do I do well? What do I like to do? Do I work better with people or alone?
 - Do I need challenge and change, or a consistent routine?

THEN: Given my abilities, aptitudes, gifts, desires and opportunity, which decision would offer the greatest potential for my service to the Lord and obedience to his moral will?
