- Romans 6:3-5

Baptism is rich in symbolism.

- Baptism is a picture of Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.
- Baptism by fully immersing a person in water.
- The physical act of baptism reminds us of the most amazing act in history.

What happens in baptism?

We publicly declare our belief and faith in Jesus.

- Mark 16:16
- Baptism, separated from faith, is just a bath.

We lower under the water to represent death, burial, and dying to sin.

- Romans 6:1-2, 6-7
- We don't earn this standing of "dead to sin."



We rise to represent our new identity as God's child.
