• Luke 19:35-40

God is worthy of praise all of the time, and there are seasons when it seems easier to praise God!

- Enjoy the blessings, and carefully still depend on God.
- Enjoy the blessings, and purposefully keep growing spiritually.

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, He knew this would lead to His death.

- Luke 19:41
- "Wept" doesn't mean tear-up; it means sobbing, weeping, and deep sorrow.
- Luke 19:42
- Disappointment happens when our expectations are not met by our experiences.
- The same people who hailed Jesus as a hero turned on Him because He disappointed them.
- Their story can be our story of feeling disappointed with God.



Be honest with Him.

- Psalm 44:23,24
- Psalm 69:3
- Psalm 22
- A sure way to let disappointment gain strength and power in our life is to hold it in and not express it to God.
- The story of Palm Sunday from victory parade into a threatening mob is the story of people who failed to deal with their disappointment with Jesus.
