- The Bible is a divinely inspired, intricate work of literary art that tells different parts of one grand story leading us to Jesus.
- Genesis 1:1-2
- The word "God" is transliterated into English as Elohim.

The Trinity

- Genesis 1:26
- The word for God here, Elohim, is plural, but it doesn't mean Gods. The verb tenses and adjectives that go with "God" are all singular, referring to ONE someone.
- This God is a "we" that says "our" and yet is still one being.
- John 1:1
- John 1:2, 3 & 14
- John asserts that we must go to the beginning of the Story of Everything to understand Jesus.

How can 3 be 1?

- The term Trinity is never used in the Bible, but it's a truth implicitly stated throughout God's Word.
- John 14:26
- God is the creator and ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The three are coequal and are one God.
