The Misconceptions About Eternity

• One of the challenges in talking about the afterlife is often many ideas come more from medieval history and popular culture than from Scripture.

The Mystery of Eternity

- There are parts of the eternal that will remain a mystery until we get there.
- The Book of Revelation is a vision that brought hope and challenge to the 1st Century churches, and to every generation of Christ followers after.

Eternity Away from God

- Revelation 20:14
- We need to come to grips with the truth that Jesus, who has shown God's love in ways no one else ever has or could, talks about Hell as a reality.
- Matthew 5:22
- The word for "Hell" that Jesus uses is Gehenna.
- Jesus uses this word 11 times.
- o It was a place of child sacrifices.
- o Mounds of human bodies were piled in Gehenna (Jer. 7:32).
- o Gehenna was the name of the garbage dump in Jerusalem.
- o (Matt. 8:12; 22:13; 25:30)
- o (Matt. 8:12; 13:42, 50; 22:13; 24:51; 25:30; Luke 13:28)
