Winning Like a Hero Maker

- How do we keep score?
- Jesus' view of "winning" looks very different than our world's view.
- He keeps score differently.

Mark 10:35-44

- Being seated on the right side was a symbolic place of importance.
- The brothers are asking for the places of highest importance and privilege.
- The world's scorecard that says, "I have to secure as much honor, position, glory, and prestige for myself if I want to 'win.'"
- Jesus completely flips our natural understanding!
- Winning like a Hero Maker requires a shift from counting my own successes to counting the successes of others.
